Dot is excited to announce the \$9.3 million expansion of its current warehouse and office space. The increased capacity resulting from the expansion project will allow for the creation of 54 new jobs.

The local expansion project has been in the works for nearly three years. Construction will commence this month. The expansion should be operational in late fall 2016.
