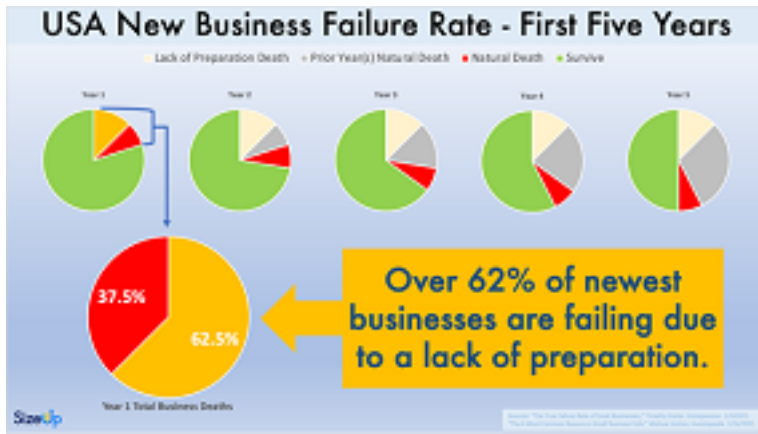
SizeUp Greater Vidalia® provides free market research to help small businesses
